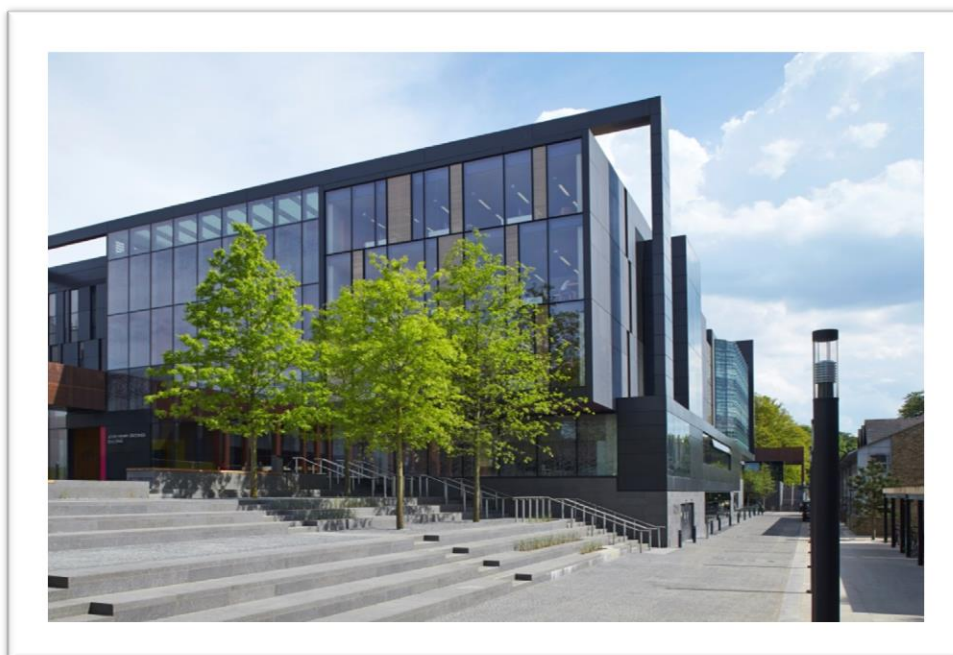


Oxford Brookes University, UK Fact Sheet 2019/20
