<p>Orientation days</p>	<p>Fall Semester : Monday 3rd and Tuesday 4th September 2018 Spring Semester : Monday January 7th 2019</p> <p>An orientation meeting is organized by the International Student Services at the start of every semester. Both the International Student Services and the International Mobility Office participate to this event to give you all necessary information.</p> <p>International students are required to attend the orientation meeting relevant to his/her period of studies at Toulouse Business School as vital information is given at that time. Attendance is compulsory.</p> <p>Further information will be sent by email closer to the start of each specific semester of study.</p>

<p>Language requirements and courses</p>	<p>Bachelor Program :</p> <p>As it is possible to follow classes either in French or English, we fully trust our partner selection to be sure that the required level in the teaching language is properly assessed for non-native speakers. We could however recommend a B2 level in English (for the English track) or a B2/C1 in French (for the French track)</p> <p>Master Program :</p> <p>As it is possible to follow classes either in French or English, we require a certificate of language proficiency (for English or French) for non-native speakers only. There will be a French intensive course scheduled after the Orientation Day of Semester 1 and Semester 2 of M1 classes. Further information will be available closer to the time of registration program no longer than two weeks prior to the exchange.</p>

<p>Nomination procedure</p>	<p>Online Nomination process An individual email will be sent to the person designated to officially nominate the exchange students, with specific information and online nomination procedure. <p>Application Procedure</p>	<p>Online application done by the student. After the closing of the nomination period and once the students' nominations have been processed, all nominated exchange students will receive a login/password and the procedure to access the online application process. On completion of the online registration, and after the closing of the registration period, exchange students will be sent a letter of Admission, provided their file is complete. No late application will be accepted. The course registration will also be done during the application process.</p> <p>Students must upload the following supporting documents online:</p> <p>For Bachelor Students : Latest grade transcript (students must have validated 60 ECTS in Business/Management). Copy of passport or Identity proof.</p> <p><i>Note : upon arrival, for French Social Health Security registration, students should be prepared to give a copy of their European Health Insurance Card (European students) or a copy of Birth Certificate for non-European students (translated into French or English)</i></p> <p>For Master Students : CV/resume Latest grade transcript A language proficiency certificate (English or French) for non-native speakers only Copy of their European Health Insurance Card for European students* Copy of their Health Insurance from Home country for non EU Students staying less than 3 months* Copy of their Birth Certificate (translated in French or English for non-European languages) Copy of their passport (ID section).</p>
